**TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN**

**Re: Manufacturer's Certification  
Restriction of Hazardous Substances (ROHS)**

In response to the European Commission's directive to ban hazardous substances in electrical and electronic products sold in Europe effective July 1, 2006, we certify now that the materials used to manufacture the products of KATKO do not contain the following:

- Lead
- Mercury
- Cadmium
- Hexavalent Chromium
- Polybrominated Biphenyls
- Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers

Exceptions are yellow-zinc plated screws and terminals. In yellow-zinc process the material contains some hexavalent chromium (Cr6+). The hexavalent chromium (Cr6+) will be replaced with Cr3+ in this process not later than January 1, 2006.
